(Activities Conducted in the Context of SVEEP)



ELC setup is under process. Electronic communication with District Election Officer has been done for the setup of ELC at Maharaja Agrasen International College. Documentational and other essential requisites are also being prepared. Under the flagship program 'Systematic Voters' Education & Electoral Participation' (SVEEP), of Election Commission of India, Rovers and Rangers of Maharaja Agrasen International College has acted as a vibrant hub for mainstreaming the Electoral Literacy through a host of co-curricular and extra-curricular methods for the young and future voters for developing and strengthening the culture of electoral participation through hands on experience. Various activities have been conducted under flagship, within and beyond classroom to sensitize the students and population about electoral rights and electoral process of registration and voting.

Since the setup of Electoral Literacy Club is under process, appointments are yet to be done by the College. Once the ELC of Maharaja Agrasen International College is set up Executive Council will be functional; **meanwhile Rover and Ranger Unit of the College has been functioning as an effective alternate for ELC.** Rover Crew and Ranger Team of the college along with its Group Leader- Dr. Digree Lal Patel and its Incharge Mr. Abhijeet Chakravorty has been organizing and conducting a series of awareness activities within college and off college premises, in the local neighborhood to encourage voter and civic education to ensure that all constituents—men and women alike—understand their rights, their political system; voters must understand the constitutional obligations and must be sufficiently knowledgeable and well informed to cast ballots that are legally valid and to participate meaningfully in the voting process.

To sensitize students and general population on electoral process, voting rights and its importance never before have, all the students of the college including faculty members, been involved in movements for **Voter Education**. They are taking to the streets and using online social networks and communities for dissemination of information, materials and programs designed to inform voters about the specifics and mechanics of the voting process for a particular election, who is eligible to vote; where and how to register; how electors can check the voter lists to ensure they have been duly included; what type of elections are being held; where, when and how to vote; who the candidates are; and how to file complaints.. The main motto of the programs and activities is <u>"Empower the Youth for a Sustainable Future and No Voter should be left behind."</u>

Many activities have been conducted to increase students participation in voter registration. Following are the detailed description of the activities done along with their supportive pictures and documents:
